EVERY HORSE OWNER/PARTICIPANT SHALL CAREFULLY READ THIS NOTICE BEFORE SIGNING. NO OWNER/PARTICIPANT WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES (CALLED THE ACTIVITY) OR HAVE THEIR HORSE BOARDED PRIOR TO READING AND SIGNING THIS FORM.

King and Sonya Campbell, their site property owners, directors, officers, employees, representatives, agents, volunteers, business operators (all of them collectively called the "HOST")

I am aware and understand that there are Inherent DANGERS, HAZARDS, AND RISKS (collectively called "RISKS") associated with Equine Activities. I acknowledge that these Inherent "RISKS" of Equine Activities mean those Dangerous conditions which are an integral part of Equine Activities, including but not limited to:

- 1. The propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and/or damage to property in their vicinity;
- 2. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;
- 3. The equine's response to certain hazards such as surface and subsurface objects;
- 4. Collisions with other equines, animals, people and objects;
- 5. The potential of any participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or to act within his or her ability.

I understand that injuries resulting from such "RISKS" are a common and ordinary occurrence associated with Equine Activities. I freely accept and fully assume all the "RISKS" and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss from being a participant. I acknowledge that it remains my sole responsibility to act in such a manner as to be responsible for my own safety and to participate within my own limits. In consideration of the "HOST" Boarding my "Horse(s) or permitting my participation in the "ACTIVITY". I together with my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, (Collectively called my "Legal Representatives") agree:

- 1. to WAIVE ALL CLAIMS that I may have against the "Host" and
- 2. To RELEASE THE "HOST" FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY for any loss, damages, injury or expenses that I or my "Legal Representatives" may suffer as a result of my horse(s) being boarded or my Participation in the "ACTIVITY" due to any cause whatsoever INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE "HOST" and,
- 3. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE "HOST" from any and all liability for any injury to the HORSES(S) or any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from my HORSE(S) being boarded or my Participation in the "ACTIVITY" and,
- 4. To maintain in effect a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 third party liability insurance on the Horse(s) while boarded and/or participating in the activity.

I have read and understand the Rules of the boarding facility and the "ACTIVITY" which apply to me. I agree to abide by those rules and Acknowledge that a breach of the Rules may among other things, result in my expulsion from the boarding facility or the "ACTIVITY". Before I signed this Release and Acknowledgement, I read it and I state that I understand it. I am aware that by signing this Release and Acknowledgement, I am waiving all legal rights which I may have against the "HOST", or if I die, by signing this Release and Acknowledgement, I am waiving all rights that my Legal Representatives may have against the "HOST".

OR IF THE OWNER/PARTICIPANT IS A MINOR (UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE AT THE DATE OF SIGNING) I am the legal guardian of the Owner/Participant named herein and am executing this Release and Acknowledgement on behalf of the Owner/Participant in my capacity as guardian and with the intent that this Release and Acknowledgement be binding by the infant Owner/Participant for all legal purposes. Before I signed this Release and Acknowledgement, I read it and I state that I understand it. I am aware that by signing this Release and Acknowledgement, I am waiving all legal rights which I may have against the "HOST", and which the infant Owner/Participant has against the "HOST". In the event of my death or the death of the infant Owner/Participant, by signing this Release and Acknowledgement, I am waiving all legal rights which my Legal Representatives or the Legal Representatives of the infant Owner/Participant may have against the "HOST".



The following policy is in place to ensure the maximum safety and enjoyment of the facilities by everyone. *Thank You*

- Personal and equine safety is of the utmost importance to us at Topline Stables. All concerns must be brought to the attention of Sonya or King Campbell.
- > Prior to anyone riding or working with the horses, a signed waiver must be provided.
- It is mandatory that ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) approved helmets and riding boots with heels be worn by all riders at all times when mounted.
- The fields and trails are available for your use; however, when jumping any cross country obstacles, riders must be accompanied by an insured coach.
- > Anyone jumping in any of the rings must have a spotter.
- Stable Insurance does not cover tack & accessories or injury/ loss of your horse(s). It is the boarders' responsibility to have their own adequate personal insurance to cover the above listed items.
- > All arena, paddock and field gates must be kept closed and latched at all times (no exceptions).
- > Participants agree to follow all rules pertaining to "permitted" shows and activities.

Additional Considerations if Boarding at Topline:

- \blacktriangleright No dogs are permitted at the stables.
- > Tack up area must be swept and tidy before and after you ride.
- > No running or yelling anywhere near the tack up area.
- Halters must be hung up and not left on the hitching rail. Nothing is to be left on the stairs. Ensure that all messes that are left by you and your horse are cleaned up.
- Park vehicles in the designated parking area only. Park only by barn when unloading grain. Do not drive past tack up area except in case of emergency.
- When you leave the stables, ensure all lights are turned off.
- Paddocks must be cleaned a minimum of 5 days per week, to maintain proper parasite control and stable cleanliness. If your paddock is not cleaned, the stable will clean it for you and you will be charged \$15.00 per cleaning.
- Grass area outside of your paddock must be kept raked and clean of all hay, shaving, rocks and manure.
- Rocks found in paddocks can be picked up and put in the manure pile or in the designated rock pile. Do not put rocks outside of the paddock where they will interfere with mowing, damage equipment and become a projectile hazard.
- > When using any equipment (wheelbarrows, rakes, forks, halters etc.) please return them to their designated area.
- > It is the responsibility of the boarders to provide salt blocks for their horse.
- All grains and pellets must be kept in sealed containers in the grain room. No grain or treats to be stored in tack room.
- All horses that are boarded at the stables are on the same deworming program. Horses shall be wormed in the first week of December using either Equimax or Equvalan Gold and April with the wormer of your choice.
